About: The Beitz Foundation was established by Myles Beitz, an Agricultural Science teacher at Muscatine High School.

The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage students to study agricultural science in undergrad and graduate school. A preference will be given to students who wish to become an agricultural science teacher.

Qualifications: To qualify for the scholarship applicants must:

- Graduate from Muscatine High School,
- Plan to study agricultural science, but not agricultural business or sales, and
- Attend any accredited undergrad or graduate program in the United States.

To Apply: Recipients of this award are selected by the agricultural science department at Muscatine High School. Students interested in the award should contact that department no later than the January of their senior year of High School.

Information for Current Recipients: Students required to reapply for their Beitz scholarship must submit the following information to the First National Bank of Muscatine Trust Department by July 1:

- An updated Transcript including the latest spring semester, and
- A letter requesting that the scholarship be renewed.

Students will be notified of the results as soon as possible by the selection committee, as late as early August. Renewal letters and transcripts may be mailed to:
